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I work on a wide range of projects from my East London studio including in-house designs handmade for retail or restaurants, bespoke items produced to a specific client brief and even designs for mass-production by factories I know and trust.



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These olive bowls were designed for Gondala Group's Zizzi restaurant chain and distributed through 3663 Catering Supplies. To date, 7000 bowls have been produced exclusively for the chain and I worked hard to find a factory I could trust to perfectly reproduce my design at a competitive price.



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Stoneware plates and platters ranging from 20cm to 35cm in diameter. These make up part of my own range of tableware produced in-house in small volumes. I finished these with bright under-glaze colours to contrast with natural clay tones on the unglazed rim.



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Another project for the restaurant chain Zizzi, this factory sample was created for a lidded sugar bowl concept they were interested in developing. The item is produced in a more traditional way, using glazed and high-fired porcelain.



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Produced in hardwearing industrial porcelain this range for Elliot's in London's Borough Market was manufactured in-house, by hand at my East London Studio. Over 270 items have been completed for Elliot's, from side plates to large sharing bowls.



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Bret Graham of The Ledbury commissioned these bowls, which are cast from a real sea urchin shell. First having to track down a sea urchin of suitable size, I then moulded and cast the pieces in fine bone china, finishing them with a gloss glaze.
